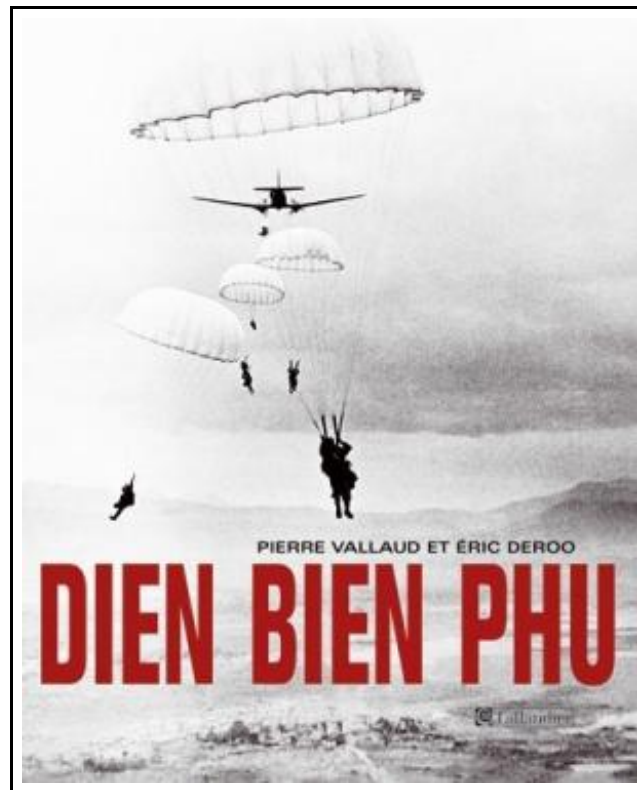

C'était sans compter sur la ténacité du Viet-minh, qui, sous la direction du général Giap et avec l'aide de 75 000 coolies, concentra autour de Diên-Biên-Phu 35 000 hommes et de nombreuses pièces d'artillerie, soumettant la garnison à un feu ininterrompu et empêchant tout ravitaillement efficace.
